Re: Amendment to the Master Agreement for the Assignment of Service and the Online Irrevocable Application for such Assignment of Service

As you may be aware, with the release of TransCanada's **NrG** Dovetail for Contracting on the Alberta system, TransCanada is now able to make a significant business process change from the Replacement model of contract management to the Versioning model of contract management.

To facilitate this change, the **Master Agreement for the Assignment of Service and the Online Irrevocable Application for such Assignment of Service** must be amended as follows:

The following paragraph of the Assignment Agreement shall be deleted in its entirety

“WHEREAS from time to time Customer will be a party to assignments of Service, as assignee or assignor.”

and replaced with the following:

“WHEREAS from time to time Customer will be a party to assignments of all or a portion of Service, as assignee or assignor.”

Paragraph 3(a) and 3(b) of the Assignment Agreement shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“3(a). Subject to paragraph 3(b), for each Electronic Application (as defined below) or Written Application (as defined below) approved by Company a schedule ("Assignment Schedule") will be prepared by Company in the form attached as Schedule "A" for permanent assignments, Schedule "B" for temporary assignments or Schedule "C" for the early reversion of temporary assignment. Schedules "A", "B" and "C" will have an appendix attached thereto setting out the Assigned or Reverted Service ("Appendix "1"). The Appendix "1" shall be incorporated into, and form part of, the Assignment Schedule to which it is attached.”

“3(b) In the case of multiple Assignments at one time, Company shall not be required to prepare an Assignment Schedule for each Assignment. The Assignment Schedule shall apply to each Assigned or Reverted Service listed in the Appendix "1”.”

Paragraph 4(b)v, 4(b)vii and 4(c)iv of the Assignment Agreement shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- “4(b)v. Each of Company and Customer are deemed, in the absence of manifest error, to accept the Assignment Schedule and Appendix “1” and any changes to other Schedules of Service relating to the Assignment;”
- “4(b)vii. Upon acceptance by Company of an Electronic Application, Company consents to the assignment of the Assigned Service and releases Assignor from any obligations and liabilities under the Assignor Service Agreement relating to the Assigned Service which arise or accrue after the Effective Time, in the case of a temporary assignment, before the Reversion Time and in the case of an early reversion, before the Early Reversion Time. The terms "Assigned Service", "Assignor", "Assignor Service Agreement", "Effective Time", "Reversion Time" and “Early Reversion Time” used in this paragraph shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Assignment Schedule in question;”
- “4(c)iv. Upon executing an Assignment Schedule, Company consents to the assignment of the Assigned Service and releases Assignor from any obligations and liabilities under the Assignor Service Agreement relating to the Assigned Service which arise or accrue after the Effective Time, in the case of a temporary assignment, before the Reversion Time and in the case of an early reversion, before the Early Reversion Time. The terms "Assigned Service", "Assignor", "Assignor Service Agreement", "Effective Time", "Reversion Time" and “Early Reversion Time” used in this paragraph shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Assignment Schedule in question;”

The effective date of the amendments shall be the date of receipt by Customer of this notice. These amendments shall only apply to Assignment Agreements and Assignment Schedules executed after the effective date of this amendment.
