



**TransCanada Alberta System (NGTL)  
Short Term Firm Transportation (STFT)  
Daily Open Season  
Updated April 30, 2008**

TransCanada is marketing available STFT capacity on its NGTL system. **The bid deadline for this open season is 10:00 am each business day, until further notice.**

**Capacity Available**

TransCanada is offering NGTL STFT capacity up to the amounts shown in the table(s) below.

**STFT Capacity available for service starting on or after May 1, 2008.**

<b>Posted Border Point</b>	<b>Volume in GJ/day</b>
Empress Border	Up to 2,400,000
McNeill Border	Up to 1,000,000
Alberta BC Border	Up to 450,000
Alberta Montana Border	Up to 6,500

- **Requests for FT-D (annual) capacity have priority over STFT.**
- **STFT Posted capacity is available with a minimum bid of 100% of the FT-D rate**
- **The January 1, 2008 approved interim rate for FT-D is \$4.45 GJ/month (14.59¢ GJ/Day).**
- **Minimum Term for STFT contracts is typically one (1) month.**
- **Balance of month bids (minimum of 7 days ending on the last day of the month) may be accepted within the month requested.**
- **Bids are evaluated and awarded based upon a calculation of bid \* term.**
- **Multiple bids by entities or their affiliates can not exceed the capacity posted.**
- **Bids for different periods/volumes/bid amounts and borders must be on separate bid forms.**

**Financial Assurance Requirements:**

Successful bidders will be required to provide financial assurances as required by TransCanada. For financial assurance information please refer to paragraph 10.1 of General Terms and Conditions of the NGTL Tariff [http://www.transcanada.com/Alberta/info\\_postings/tariff/gtc.pdf](http://www.transcanada.com/Alberta/info_postings/tariff/gtc.pdf).

**Bidding and Allocation Procedure:**

As outlined in [Appendix A](#) the NGTL tariff, titled "Terms and Conditions Respecting Access to Transportation Service at Export Border Points" all parties wishing to bid for this available service can do so by completing the STFT Service Agreement and Schedule of Service.

**Evaluation of Bids**

Bids will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

1. Bid Price multiplied by contract term.
2. Commencement of service date if bids are otherwise equivalent i.e. service commencing on earlier start dates will be given higher priority.
3. If oversubscribed, tied bids will be allocated on a prorated basis



**Submitting Bids:**

A completed and executed Schedule of Service should be **faxed to NGTL STFT Open Season (403) 920-2341**. No deposits are required. Bid information should include a minimum and maximum quantity acceptable to the bidder.

After the open season closes, we will notify customers as soon as possible.
