

## Upcoming Changes to NGTL (Alberta System) Invoice

To: NGTL Customers

The following is to advise you of upcoming changes with the Demand and Commodity charges on the NGTL invoice.

The Invoice Today. The NGTL invoice contains Demand charges for the Billing Month and Commodity charges for the *month preceding* the Billing Month (there is a one-month lag before actual Commodity charges appear on the invoice).

The Tolls, Tariff & Procedures Committee (TTFP) has approved changes to the Industry Calendar which will enable the alignment of Demand and Commodity charges on the NGTL invoice. Pending Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (EUB) approval of proposed Tariff language, the following changes will become effective on **October 1, 2006**:

Demand/Commodity Alignment. In order to align the Demand and Commodity charges to appear on the same invoice, Customers will receive a *one-time additional invoice on or about September 22, 2006* (in addition to the regular monthly invoice issued in September 2006). This *second* invoice will contain only the August Commodity charges and is payable to NGTL within 10 days of its issue.

We suggest you make appropriate preparations for this additional invoice. A review of your historical monthly Commodity charges may provide an estimate of the invoice amount.

Starting with the invoice issued in October 2006, the NGTL invoice will contain both Demand and Commodity charges for the same Billing Month.

Industry Calendar and Tariff Changes. NGTL collaborated with industry to develop an Industry Calendar which accommodates the Demand and Commodity alignment. The revised calendar and Tariff changes propose that:

- NGTL will provide Customers with their electronic invoices on TransCanada's Electronic Bulletin Board (EBB) on or before the 21<sup>st</sup> day of each month (previously invoices were rendered by the 20<sup>th</sup> day); and
- All NGTL Tariff and Industry Calendar references to the invoice shall refer to the electronic invoice only; i.e. the official invoice of record which NGTL will provide to Customers each month is the electronic version.

### No Changes

The current invoicing processes for the following services will remain unchanged:

- FT-P, LRS, LRS-2, LRS-3, PTS and CO<sub>2</sub>.

After the electronic invoice is posted on TransCanada's EBB, paper copies of the invoice will be provided to Customers who require them.
