



**Foothills Pipe Lines Ltd.  
Winter 2007/2008 Open Season for  
Short Term Firm Transportation (STFT)  
March 1, 2008**

Foothills Pipe Lines Ltd. (Foothills) is marketing available STFT capacity on the Foothills BC System (Zone 8). **The bid deadline for this open season is 10:00 AM each business day.**

**Capacity Available:**

Foothills BC (Zone 8) is offering STFT capacity up to the amounts shown in the table below.

Time Period	Volume in GJ/day
March 1 to 31, 2008	Up to 150,000

- **The STFT minimum bid price is 100% of the FT rate.**
- **Bids are evaluated and awarded based upon a calculation of bid \* term.**
- **Multiple bids by entities or their affiliates can not exceed the capacity posted.**

**Financial Assurance Requirements:**

Pursuant to section 5.8 of the General Terms and Conditions of the Foothills Tariff, the successful bidders will be required to provide financial assurances as required by TransCanada.

**Bidding and Allocation Procedure:**

As outlined in section 4.2 of the Capacity Allocation Procedures for STFT Service, all parties wishing to bid for this available service can do so by completing the Schedule A. Any bid received is binding, subject to the conditions outlined in 4.2.2 of the Capacity Allocation Procedures. The STFT Service Agreement and Schedule A can be seen at this link [Foothills STFT Agreement and Schedule A](#). This link, [Foothills Smart Form](#), provides customers with a smart form which helps to complete the STFT schedule of service. No deposits are required.

**Please note that the minimum bid is 100% of the NEB approved FT rate.** The 2007 tolls approved by the National Energy Board (NEB) equals a full haul rate of \$0.075/GJ/day. The proposed interim tolls for 2008, equals a full haul rate of \$0.092/GJ/day.

**Foothills GST Procedure – For Export STFT Contracts Only**

For the purpose of billing GST on export contracts, TransCanada requires Shippers to provide a Declaration. The Declaration notifies TransCanada that the Shipper's STFT service is intended to serve an export market and should be charged 0% GST, including any potential Unutilized Demand Charges (UDC). Shippers who wish to be charged 0% GST on their STFT service and any potential UDC's must execute a Declaration. **To do this, the Shipper is requested to execute and return the STFT Declaration attached to the bid form prior to the effective date for each STFT contract entered into.** If the STFT service is not for export and should be charged 6% GST please disregard the Declaration attached to the bid form.

**Submitting Bids:**
