



**Foothills Pipe Lines Ltd.
Short Term Firm Transportation (STFT)
Daily Open Season
Updated on March 7, 2007**

Foothills Pipe Lines Ltd. (Foothills) is marketing available STFT Service on Foothills Saskatchewan System (Zone 9). **The bid deadline for this open season is 10:00 AM each business day.**

Capacity Available:

Foothills Zone 9 is offering STFT capacity up to the amounts shown in the table below.

Time Period	Volume in GJ/day	Volume in MMcf/day
March 1 to October 31, 2007	Up to 600,660	Up to 560
April 1 to October 31, 2007	Up to 917,750	Up to 860

- **Requests for T-1 (annual) capacity have priority over STFT.**
- **Minimum Term for STFT contracts is typically one (1) month.**
- **Balance of month bids (minimum of 7 days ending on the last day of the month) may be accepted within the month requested.**
- **The STFT minimum bid price is 100% of the T-1 rate.**
- **Bids are evaluated and awarded based upon a calculation of bid * term.**
- **Multiple bids by entities or their affiliates can not exceed the capacity posted.**
- **Bids for different periods/volumes and amounts must be on separate bid forms.**

Financial Assurance Requirements:

Pursuant to section 5.8 of the General Terms and Conditions of the Foothills Tariff the successful bidders will be required to provide financial assurances as required by TransCanada.

Bidding and Allocation Procedure:

As outlined in section 4.2 of the Capacity Allocation Procedures for STFT Service, all parties wishing to bid for this available service can do so by completing the STFT Service Agreement and Schedule A. Any bid received is binding subject to the conditions outlined in 4.2.2 of the Capacity Allocation Procedures. This link [Foothills Smart Form](#) provides customers with a smart form which helps to complete the STFT agreement and schedule of service.

Please note that the minimum bid is 100% of the NEB approved interim T-1 rate for 2007. The 2007 interim toll approved by the National Energy Board (NEB) include a T-1 Monthly Rate of \$0.380908/103m³/km, which converts to a full haul rate of \$2.76/103m³/d (8.6 cents/GJ) .

Foothills GST Procedure – For Export STFT Contracts Only

For the purpose of billing GST on export contracts, TransCanada requires Shippers to provide a Declaration which notifies TransCanada that the Shipper's STFT service is intended to serve an export market and should be charged 0% GST, including any potential Unutilized Demand Charges (UDC). Shippers who wish to be charged 0% GST on their STFT service and any potential UDC's must execute a Declaration. **To do this, the Shipper is requested to execute and return the STFT Declaration attached to the bid form prior to the effective date for each STFT contract entered into.** If the STFT service is not for export and should be charged 6% GST please disregard the Declaration attached to the bid form.



Submitting Bids:

Your completed and executed STFT Service Agreement and Schedule A should be faxed to Foothills STFT Open Season (403) 920-2384. After the open season closes, we will notify customers as soon as possible. No deposits are required.
