**RE: Foothills Pipe Lines Ltd.
Jenner Compressor Station (367-1)
50,000 Hour Overhaul**

In accordance with Board Order XG/XO-100-94 as amended, Foothills Pipe Lines Ltd. on behalf of Foothills Pipe Lines (Alta.) Ltd. (collectively "Foothills"), hereby provides the Board with the required notice of a project to be conducted pursuant to Schedule A of the above-noted Order.

The gas turbine engine (RB-211) at the Jenner Compressor Station (367-1) has reached its 50,000 hour operating life cycle. In order to maintain engine integrity and reliability, at 50,000 hours, the engine is stripped to its base and key components replaced in order to return the engine to zero-hour condition.

The total estimated cost of the program is \$1.7 million. Foothills intends to begin this work in the first quarter of the year 2000.
