NorthWest Mainline Capacity Non-Critical Notice

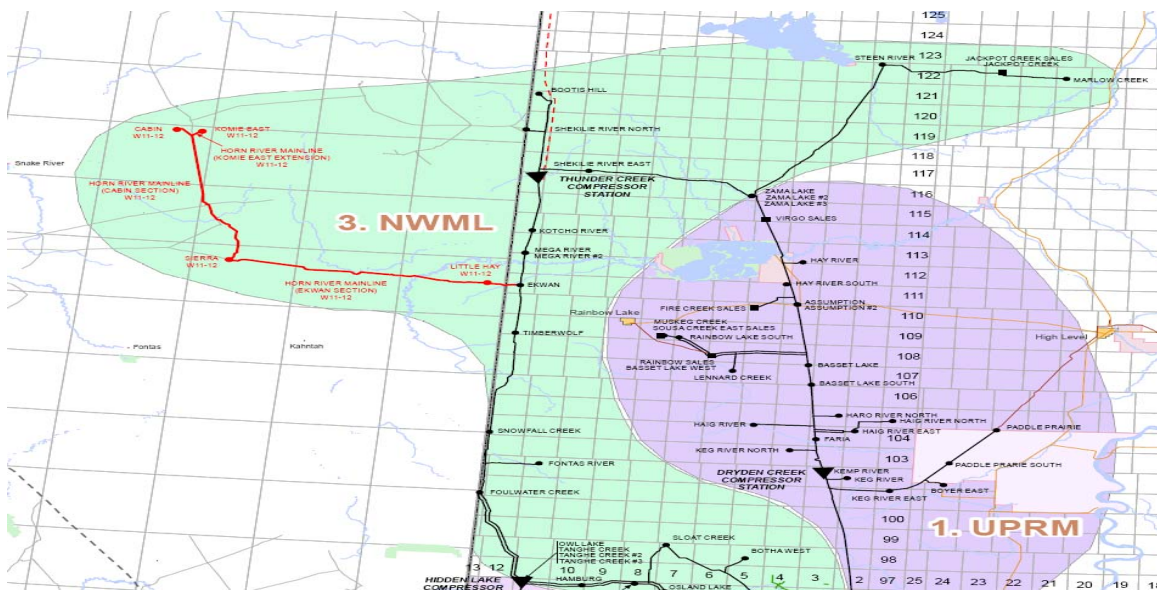
NOVA Gas Transmission (NGTL) continues to review the mainline capacity in Segment 3 (NWML). Future authorized FT-R contracts in this area has limited the current available capacity on the NWML. NGTL advises Customers it anticipates an expansion of existing mainline facilities in this area may be required by April 2013, based on NGTL's flow projections, taking into account current and future FT-R contract commitments, and future potential receipt volumes.

As previously communicated in the [September 2, 2009 bulletin \(see below\)](#), requests for new FT-R service or transfers of existing contracts into the area will be accepted until the capacity in the area is fully contracted.

NGTL suggests that Customers review their future Firm Service requirements in this area to ensure that their Firm Service levels meet their expected requirements. In the event that Customers submit additional service requests that exceed uncontracted capacity, NGTL will allocate capacity in accordance with its established queuing practice. Available uncontracted capacity will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.

If additional facilities in this area are required to meet aggregate service requests, NGTL must receive any additional FT-R service requests by November 1, 2010 to have sufficient time to apply-for, construct and place the necessary facilities in-service by April 2013.

NOVA Gas Transmission (NGTL) has completed a review of mainline capacity in Segment 3 (NWML) and Segment 1 (UPRM). The review indicates available uncontracted capacity is decreasing due to increased FT-R Contract levels in this area.

NGTL advises Customers it anticipates an expansion of existing mainline facilities in this area may be required by April 2012, based on NGTL's flow projections, taking into account current and future FT-R contract commitments, and future potential receipt volumes predominantly from the emerging Horn River basin.

Requests for new FT-R service or transfers of existing contracts into the area will be accepted until the capacity in the area is fully contracted (dependent on available meter station and downstream capacity).
